In the area of the occurrence, Jurassic basic volcanic rocks have been intruded by diorite which, in turn, has been intruded by quartz monzonite and quartz porphyry dikes. Breccia pipes showing varying degrees of alteration and mineralization have been formed. Chalcopyrite, bornite, malachite and molybdenite occur in quartz stringers, and as disseminations, in the breccia pipes.

The occurrence is located at the SW end of McClinchy Lake, 11 miles SW of Charlotte Lake, and 17 miles SE of Tenas Lake.

In 1969, Anaconda American Brass Limited owned the property consisting of the KF 1 to 24 claims. The property was mapped both geologically and topographically. A geochemical survey was conducted on 370 silt and soil samples. Five line-miles of induced polarization, magnetometer and seismic surveys was completed. Four holes were diamond drilled totalling 600 feet.

In 1970, the property was reduced to 23 claims. Work during the year included an induced polarization survey of 9 line-miles. By 1971, the property was reduced to 11 claims. A magnetometer survey was carried out during the year.

In 1972, J.H. Montgomery owned the KF property consisting of the C 1 to 23, MJ 1 to 10, DK 1 to 5, DK 6 Fraction, DK 7 to 13 and DK 14 Fraction claims. The property was optioned to Casper Management Ltd. who, 14 days later, re-optioned it to Cardwell Resources Ltd. This company carried out geological mapping, a geochemical survey, a magnetometer survey and an induced polarization survey.

In 1973, J.H. Montgomery still owned the property, however, the operator was Rio Tinto Canadian Exploration Limited. They drilled two holes, one on C 17 and one on DK 11, totalling 391 feet.
