DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

In places the granitic rock northeast of Tachek Mtn shows slight mineralization of chalcopryrite and pyrite. At one point the granitic rock is cut by an andesite dyke about $2\frac{1}{2}$ feet in width. Both walls of the dyke contain a few inches of breccia, cemented with quartz and mineralized with chalcopryrite. A selected sample assayed 0.02 ounce gold and 0.8 ounce silver per ton.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The occurrence is located within an area of granitic rock north and east of Tachek Mountain, some 8 miles north-east of Topley.

Mr. L. Bartholomew prospected this area for a number of years in the early 1930's; no claims were staked.
