## **DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT**

In places the granitic rock northeast of Tachek Mtn shows slight mineralization of chalcopyrite and pyrite. At one point the granitic rock is cut by an andesite dyke about  $2\frac{1}{2}$  feet in width. Both walls of the dyke contain a few inches of breccia, cemented with quartz and mineralized with chalcopyrite. A selected sample assayed 0.02 ounce gold and 0.8 ounce silver per ton.

## HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The occurrence is located within an area of granitic rock north and east of Tachek Mountain, some 8 miles northeast of Topley.

Mr. L. Bartholomew prospected this area for a number of years in the early 1930's; no claims were staked.
