DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

The claims are underlain by a massive, thick-bedded, grey to black limestone unit with fine grey, sometimes brecciated, coarse white-cream dolomitic zones which is overlain by grey slates (Middle Devonian ?). Mineralization includes disseminated fine galena, coarse light sphalerite, and minor pyrite in stockworks crosscutting the carbonate unit. Iron oxide and cerussite occur in bleached stockwork.

Associated minerals or products of value - Zinc.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located 7 miles north-northeast of Nina Lake, between 4,500 and 5,600 feet elevation.

The Osi 1-32 claims were held during 1973-1974 by S.E.R.E.M. Ltd. Work included geological mapping and geochemical surveys comprising 1,581 soil and 42 rock chip samples.
